

External Scholarship Description Examples

Example 1

The Marine Corp is offering scholarships for children of Marines pursuing a post-secondary education at any accredited school. We are a financial need scholarship, and we award scholarships to every eligible applicant. Since 1962, the Scholarship Foundation has provided more than 40,000 need-based scholarships, valued at over \$135 million. We are the Nation's oldest and largest provider of scholarships to military families. Our scholarship application is open year-round for students pursuing career and technical education programs less than 12 months in length. Student can apply at www.mcsf.org/cte. For programs longer than 12 months, our application is open from January 1 to March 1 each year.

Excel University is pleased to offer the following scholarships to outstanding accounting students.

- A declared accounting major or have an emphasis in accounting
- A legal resident of the United States or hold a valid student visa

Established in 2007 by Julian Rowe and the Waupaca Area Community Foundation, the Isabelle Rowe Nursing Scholarship seeks to assist non-traditional students (age 21 or older) who reside in the Waupaca or Fox Valley areas in WI and are pursuing a degree in nursing at a college/university or technical school.

Number of awards may vary. Up to \$1,000 award for tuition expenses for part-time or up to \$2,000 for full-time students is available.
