Requirements for Admission to the Teacher Education Program

Students wishing to transfer to UW-Superior after completing the Associate of Arts – Liberal Arts Transfer Education Pre-Major are guaranteed admission to the Elementary Education major given that all admission requirements are met.

- Completion of Madison College Liberal Arts Transfer - Education Pre-Major in alignment using the guide below
- Cumulative Honors GPA of at least 2.75 for entrance into the Teacher Education Program.
 - Honors GPA is the combined GPA of all college-level coursework, both transfer and UW-Superior.
- TED 100 Orientation to Education to be successfully completed during the first term at UW-Superior and a grade of at least “B” in TED 200 Introduction to Education.
 - 20-809-216 Introduction to Education and Teaching transfers as TED 200 Introduction to Education. A grade of “B” or higher must be earned for program admission.

Students who present a cumulative GPA of 2.75 with a completed Associate of Arts – Liberal Arts Transfer Education Pre-Major will be offered guaranteed admission at Junior status into the Teacher Education program at UW-Superior. Transferring to UW-Superior

The University of Wisconsin-Superior accepts credits for transfer to satisfy major requirements as noted in this guide. Grades earned must be a “D-” grade (or higher) for transfer, but some degree programs require at least a "C" or higher in order to transfer. To transfer credits an official transcript must be sent directly to the University of Wisconsin-Superior, as part of the university admissions process.

Students transferring to UW-Superior from this program with 12 or more earned credits and a cumulative grade point average of 2.0 or better will usually be admitted in good standing. This is in reference to admissions to UW-Superior, not the Teacher Education Program. Certain programs, such as the Teacher Education Program, may have a higher grade point average requirement to be admitted into the program.







UW-Superior’s Graduation Requirements

Overall Bachelor’s Degree requirements:

- Completion of the University Studies requirements.
- Completion of the requirements for major, minor and/or comprehensive major.
- 120 (or more) total undergraduate credits, i.e. courses numbered 100-499.
 - Elective courses may be needed to earn at least 120 credits.
- 36 (or more) undergraduate credits in upper-division courses, i.e. courses numbered 300-499.
- A resident grade point average of 2.0 (or above) for all undergraduate credits.
- 30 (or more) undergraduate credits earned at UW-Superior.
- The last 12 undergraduate credits earned at UW-Superior.
- **Please note that completion of education programs have additional requirements.**
