POLICY PURPOSE:

Madison Area Technical College (“Madison College”) recognizes that business and industry within the District compete in a global economy and that local issues are connected to global systems and processes.

POLICY:

It is important for Madison College to reflect the social, political, cultural, and economic dimensions of this global environment in its program and services. In addition, students need to develop an understanding and appreciation of this global environment, either from personal experience in a multicultural society, or through an appreciation of the implications of politics, economics, and technology in different parts of the world. Therefore, Madison College will engage in programs and initiatives that provide students, faculty, staff and the community with the knowledge, skills, and attitudes needed for productive life in a globally interconnected world.

The District will engage in such international activities including, but not limited to:

- International student enrollment as consistent with state and federal policies
- Education abroad programs consistent with best practices for health, safety, and program oversight
- Integration of global competencies within instructional curriculum across Madison College
- Faculty and staff development that allows for engagement with global issues relevant to Madison College programs and services

- Partnerships with other organizations, institutions, and entities that support the mission, goals, and internationalization initiatives of Madison College
- Contract Training as consistent with institutional, state, and federal policies.
