## POLICY PURPOSE:

Establishes the role of the Student Activities Board's (SAB) responsibility for the distribution of supplemental student fees.

## POLICY:

Supplemental fees are used to fund a wide variety of programs that appeal to a diverse student body. The Student Activities Board is responsible for the disbursement of supplemental fees in accordance with WI Statutes Act 101 (s.38.145). Supplemental fees to fund these activities are collected from all students, with the exception of apprentices, who are registered for degree credit courses. The amount of the per credit fee is 6.5% of the cost of tuition for the Metro and Online degree courses and \$3.25 for Regional Campus courses.
