## GUIDELINES/PROCEDURES:

The development process:

- Utilizes a collaborative approach with stakeholders
- Includes and loops out with other Shared Governance bodies and related committees including District Board
- Is open and transparent

Each plan developed under the Sustainability Policy will:

1. Promote strategies for environmental, social or economic sustainability that align with the mission, vision and values of the college
2. Focus on one specific area of sustainability, such as renewable and/or alternative energy, water management, waste management, recycling, or a related initiative
3. Establish goals, benchmarks and measureable targets with periodic reviews of progress
4. Establish continual communication practices to inform stakeholders
5. Engage all stakeholders in executing the plan (internal and external)
6. Respond to the changing needs of the college and all stakeholders across the district
7. Maximize the use of new and existing facilities, spaces and resources while meeting sustainability management goals
8. Collaborate with facilities and other operational departments
